

Dow in Louisiana

- Dow is big in Louisiana
 - 21 Billion lbs of production
 - \$1 Billion of Economic Impact
 - Invests \$200MM/yr in capital on average
 - 6000 jobs
- Home to two of Dow's largest integrated sites with raw materials, utilities, logistics, trained workforce and Dow's global businesses in all portfolios as well as two other sites in growth markets
- Key issues that may limit future growth are natural gas/feedstock supply & cost, captive rail, litigation costs


World Natural Gas Costs ^{\$U.S./MMbtu}
