

# LSU Tigerland and Auxiliary Leadership Camp June 23-25, 2024

## Packing List

As you prepare for a great week camp, we have created this document to make sure you know what you should bring with you:

#### At Check-In:

 Residential Participants Only: Room key deposit check for \$20 made out to LSU. This check will be returned to you or shredded once the room key is returned at check-out. If the key is lost or damaged, the \$20 fee will be assessed. A fee will also be assessed if a participant has more than 2 lockout requests during their stay.

### Supplies/Items:

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- Water bottle (labeled with your name)
- Sunscreen
- Hat/Sunglasses
- Pencils
- A light backpack to carry personal items (optional)

### Colorguard

- Flagpole with silk
- Colorguard rifle (if interested/experienced)
- Black athletic pants

### Drumline

- Drums and instrument stands, if possible.
  - o If you are unable to secure a drum from your school, please reach out to us directly at <a href="mailto:bands@lsu.edu">bands@lsu.edu</a>.
- Marching percussion items (sticks, mallets, etc.)
- Ear plugs

#### **Medications:**

 If you are on any regular medications, make sure you bring them in their original prescribed container. We will collect these at registration and have a counselor responsible for getting these to you. They *must* be in their original prescribed bottle with your name on it.

#### Attire:

- Casual clothes for daily activities. Please make sure to dress appropriately
  as you would for school. If your attire is deemed inappropriate, a staff
  member may ask you to return to your room and change.
- Comfortable athletic shoes for marching/movement (sandals/open-toed shoes are not allowed during instructional sessions)
- Sweater or light jacket A/C is cold (and unpredictable) in some of the buildings
- Umbrella or rain gear
- Performance attire:
  - o Camp shirt (provided at registration)
  - o Black athletic pants and jazz shoes (tan/black colorguard only)
  - o Black shorts (Drumline and drum majors only)

### Residence Halls (residents only):

- Twin XL sheets, pillow, pillowcase, blanket or sleeping bag
- Toiletries (shampoo, toothpaste, deodorant, etc.)
- Bath towel/washcloth
- Alarm clock/charger for phone (if your phone is your alarm clock)
- Shower Shoes
- Room Key Deposit: A check for \$20 to cover the replacement cost of a room key. The check will be returned to you upon return of the key. If the key is lost or damaged, the \$20 check will be assessed. A fee will also be assessed if a participant has more than 2 lockout requests during their stay.
