Packing List

As you prepare for a great week of music making, we have created this document to make sure you know what you should bring with you to camp:

At Check-In:

- Camp Policies Document Signed (this will be emailed to attendees)
- Residential Participants Only: Room key deposit check for \$50 made out to LSU. *This check will be returned to you or shredded once the room key is returned at check-out. If the key is lost or damaged, the \$50 fee will be assessed.*

Musical Supplies/Items:

- Instrument and supplies (folder/binder for music, mutes, reeds, valve/key oil, mallets, etc.)
- Metronome/Tuner
- Pencils
- Short selection of music to be played during your initial section meetings (no more than 5 minutes) which will serve as your audition
- Piece with piano accompaniment for those interested in possibly performing on the student recital Wednesday evening ([Click here](#) to let us know you're interested!)
- Etude books, solos for use during lessons
- A light backpack to carry personal items (optional)
- Water Bottle

Medications:

- If you are on any regular medications, make sure you bring them in their original prescribed container. We will collect these at registration and have a counselor responsible for getting these to you. They *must* be in their original prescribed bottle with your name on it.

Attire:

- Casual clothes for daily activities. Please make sure to dress appropriately as you would for school. If your attire is deemed inappropriate, a staff member may ask you to return to your room and change.
- Sweater or light jacket – A/C is cold (and unpredictable) in some of the buildings
- Umbrella or rain gear

- Recital/Concert Attire: Conservative concert black
 - Solid black long-sleeve shirt, blouse, or dress. Solid black dress pants, pantsuit, dress, or skirt that reaches fully down to the ankles. Slits in dresses and skirts should stay below the knee.

Residence Halls (residents only):

- Twin sheets, pillow, pillowcase, blanket or sleeping bag
- Toiletries (shampoo, toothpaste, deodorant, etc.)
- Bath towel/washcloth
- Alarm clock/charger for phone (if your phone is your alarm clock)
- Shower Shoes
- Room Key Deposit: A check for \$50 to cover the replacement cost of a room key. The check will be returned to you upon return of the key. If the key is lost or damaged, the \$50 check will be assessed.
