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# Fire Service Instructor III Certification Requirements

### **Entrance Requirements**

The skill level for Fire Service Instructor III, as determined by the Certification Advisory Committee, is focused on the fire service person responsible for managing a training division or developing a training program.

It is with this purpose that the Fire Instructor III level is established within this standard. These requirements reflect the minimum requirements as found in NFPA 1041, 2019, chapter 6.

In order to certify in the Louisiana **Instructor III** program, firefighters must complete the following process:

- 1- Be certified as an Instructor II with the Louisiana Firefighter and Emergency Responder Certification system.
- 2- Submit completed Portfolio **or** documentation of course completion from the approved National Fire Academy courses listed below to the LSU FETI Certification office.
- 3- Depending on method used (Portfolio or NFA Course Completion) the submitted documentation will be evaluated. Once approved, Instructor III candidate will be notified and may move to the next step in the process.
- 4- Request Fire Instructor III written examination.
- 5- Receive certification upon completion of the Portfolio or NFA Course Completion and Written Examination.

#### **Training Courses**

There is no set course to obtain Instructor III certification but FETI does offer a 40-hour program designed to help the candidate dedicate the time to completing the portfolio. Due to the nature of the requirements for Instructor III, majority of training is received on the job and through practical experience. The 40-hour course will help you use the form to complete the portfolio. At the conclusion of the course, you will either turn in your portfolio for review or continue to complete your portfolio on your own.

## **National Fire Academy Course Method**

Participants seeking Fire Instructor III by completing the NFA **course method** must provide copies of the course completion certificates awarded at the end of the NFA courses. You must have attended and completed the courses within 5 years. Both of the following courses are required:

- 1. Fire and Emergency Services Training Program Management R0445 (formerly called Training Program Management)
- 2. Training Program Design M0576 (formerly called Fire Service Course Design)

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#### **Portfolio Method**

Participants using the Fire Instructor III **portfolio method** must successfully complete the Instructor III Requirements Form contained within this packet. Documentation is required to provide proof that all requirements and skills are met. If using the portfolio method, the information is detailed later on in this packet.

This Requirement Form is self-directing in what is being required by the Certification Council to become eligible to receive Instructor III certification. **Documentation** must accompany this form to provide the necessary proof that the candidate has met the requirements as outlined by NFPA 1041 (2019), chapter 6, as adopted by the Certification Advisory Committee.

Once the Instructor III Requirements Form and appropriate documentation have been submitted to the Certification Office, they will be submitted to a qualified reviewer, and evaluated for approval. If deficiencies are found, the reviewer will work with the candidate to correct those areas. Once the review is completed and the portfolio is approved, the candidate will be recommended to move on to the written examination.

#### Written Examination

Once approved, using **either** the portfolio or NFA course completion method, the candidate is eligible for the written examination.

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Once the candidate has completed either the NFA Course or Portfolio method and passed the written examination they will be certified Fire Service Instructor III within the state of Louisiana.
