Fireflies

What's the gist?

- Fireflies are also called "lightning bugs."
- Fireflies are beetles and not flies.
- They have an interesting life cycle whereby they go through "complete metamorphosis," like frogs and butterflies, consisting of 4 stages: egg, larva, pupa, and adult.
- The firefly's eggs and larva glows, and the larva is sometimes called glowworms.
- Fireflies are found in marshes and wet wooded areas and even grid habitats.
- Worldwide, there have been identified more that 2000 species of fireflies. Fireflies that are "nocturnal," come out at night, and light up by a chemical process called "bioluminescence." The prefix "bio," means living, and, "luminescence," light production.
- The light production is used to attract mates and to warn predators like toads, lizard, snakes, and birds not to eat them or they will get sick.
- The flash patterns differ among species of fireflies and they use them to identify and "chat" with members of their species.
- One species of female fireflies has learned the flash patterns of males of other species and will attract them and eat them for dinner!
- Not all fireflies flash. Some use chemical scent called "pheromones" to attract mates, or a combination of light and chemical scent. F
